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2. Mission and vision

University American College mission statement was founded with the understanding that all people are enriched by education. The UACS mission is to provide excellence in higher education by combining the best of European and American educational standards. In accordance with this, the following activities are a significant part of the UACS mission:

- To offer education in the English language for local and foreign students at all levels, undergraduate and graduate, preparing them for work in governments, international and European organizations, businesses and industry, as well as to teach English, Macedonian and other languages.
- To develop and implement a privileged relationship with the private sector and NGO communities, serving as an educational and training resource for them and preparing students to enter the working world with appropriate skills.
- To foster leadership, service and international understanding in local, regional and global communities, as well as academic cooperation with those communities through joint academic programs and joint degrees.
- To build students' abilities in communication and public speaking, analysis, problem solving, ethics, social interaction, effective citizenship, aesthetic engagement and physical culture.
- To sponsor inclusion of European (EU) and American content in all curricula.
- To participate in the new European High Education Area (EHEA) and the European Research Area (ERA).
- To focus on quality in all areas of its activity.

University American College Skopje aims at achieving the level of an institution which will grant degrees in many areas, undergraduate and graduate, such as: BA, BS, LLB, MBA, MA, MS, LLM and PhD.

3. Institutional Report

American College Skopje was established in 2005 as a School of Business Administration. It was one of the few independent private colleges in the Republic of Macedonia. In 2006, license from the Board of the Accreditation and the Ministry of Education, was issued for transformation into a University.

We believe that the quality improvement is a continuous process. Thus, periodically each academic program is appended to meet the needs of the community.

In 2006, additional accreditation for professional training for school's head masters was granted to University American College Skopje. In 2007, UACS obtained a license to transform the School of Public Administration into School of Law.

University American College Skopje promotes the programs that use the English language as their language of instruction.

The University retains its autonomous private status while it is part of the Macedonian educational establishment as a fully recognized University by the Ministry for Education and Science of the Republic of Macedonia.

In order to achieve the mission goals of the University, the pillars of the university are the faculty. Our policy is based on the following pillars:

- Experienced professionals with academic degrees;
- International faculty

In order to maintain high levels of educational success, each member of the faculty is monitored and trained to conform to the needs of the department or school

where they teach. During the course of year, various academic training programs are delivered in the University and other Universities abroad, which introduced to our junior and senior academic staff new teaching methods, assessment methods and professional development in the areas of communication and IT.

The University employs a formalized promotion and tenure review process involving classroom observation, post observation review and peer review.

4. Accreditation

The University American College Skopje is fully accredited by the state Board of accreditation in the Republic of Macedonia, and approved to operate an institution for higher learning by the Ministry for Education in the Republic of Macedonia.

*(Article 46 section 2, Law for higher education of Republic of Macedonia; **Official Gazette** of the Republic of **Macedonia**, No: 64/2000 and 49/2003).*

The latest submission to the board for improvement, adaptation and validation to the academic programs has been approved and validated to provide the University with degree awarding programs in the field of the Legal and Administrative studies, Architecture & Design and Computers Science & Information Technology.

University American College Skopje during 2007 has made significant strategic changes:

School of Architecture and Design has been promoted from granting Associate Degrees to Bachelor degrees

(Listed under 12-6816/5 in the registry of the Agency for Accreditation and Validation)

School of Information Technology and Computer Science has been promoted from granting Associate degrees to Bachelor degrees

(Listed under 12-6816/6 in the registry of the Agency for Accreditation and Validation)

School of Public Administration has been transformed into School of Legal and Administrative studies

(Listed under 12-6816/4 in the registry of the Agency for Accreditation and Validation)

Besides the national accrediting body, the University is expanding its provision to meet the demand and needs of students that live in the USA. For this purpose we have initiated and put into motion complex procedures that will ultimately lead to UACS becoming an institution that will ultimately be accredited and validated by a national accrediting body in the USA.

Furthermore, UACS has submitted an application for the Graduate program in International Relations and Diplomacy, which is expected to be granted in 2008.

5. Infrastructure and Technology

The University has invested heavily in technology, furniture and other supporting infrastructure to enable smooth operation of the plant to foster greater understanding and learning amongst all students. During this year the policy for development had invested into acquisition of additional teaching and administrative space. To promote greater learning, each new classroom was equipped with state of the art electronic equipment for greater outcome and dependability of knowledge acquisition and retention.



The premises have been expanded from 1.600 m² to almost 3.600 m².

University American College Skopje has doubled the computer labs, and the number of lecturing rooms. As of 2009 the universities premises consist of: 3 Amphitheatres, 5 computer labs, one reading room,

one book store and Library.

As the student body enlarges, more facilities are allocated for their use and constant investment is needed to provide quality education for the student body. The University Library is constantly procuring new books for the student body, as well as the local community. The exclusive contract, which was struck for the right

to purchase books from Pearson, Prentice Hall and their subsidiaries, has allowed students at UACS to purchase quality textbook at reasonable rates.

6e. School of Foreign Languages



European Commission has emphasized the need for Macedonian translators in the process of EU admission. Here, we are trying to create language professionals in two concentrations:

- *English Language Teaching & Literature*
- *Translation and Interpretation*

Courses are delivered for full time students in English.

In the academic year 2008-2009 the School of Foreign Languages has seen further expansion and new developments. Dr. Ivan Dodovski has received a full-time lectureship, and has begun teaching literature courses, Shakespeare, and creative writing. Marjana Vaneva (M.A. in linguistics and contrastive analysis) has been hired as a part-time language instructor to strengthen the teaching capacity and research potential of the English department.

Committed to knowledge share and academic exchange, and aimed at raising of its research profile, the School of Foreign Languages has initiated a series of research seminars. A number of scholars from the UACS and other universities have been invited to present new papers. The seminars have demonstrated a range of interests from purely linguistic exploration (for example, in lexical synonymy and zero derivation in English) to literary analysis and interdisciplinary studies (for instance, investigating the representation of gender in contemporary literature for children, or Irish poetry and the Holocaust).

The School of Foreign Languages has started a process of curriculum development to introduce new mandatory and elective courses, fine-tuning the three existing undergraduate concentrations (in teaching English language and literature; translation and interpreting; and technical and professional communication). An exceptional breakthrough is the introduction of courses of four European languages – French, Italian, Spanish, and German – to be offered in the following year to all students studying at the UACS.

The end of the academic year 2008-2009 has been marked by the graduation ceremony for the first generation of undergraduate students from the English department. The School of Foreign Languages is proud to see that all students have been employed within a month from graduation.

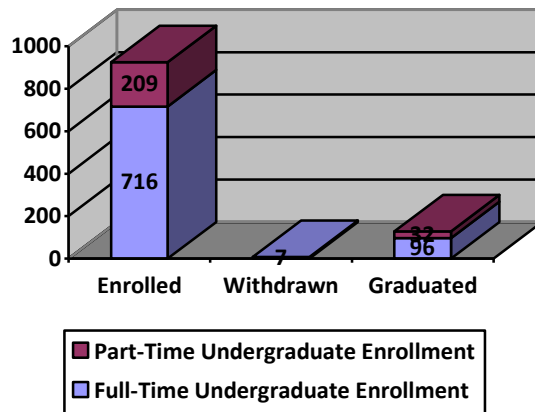

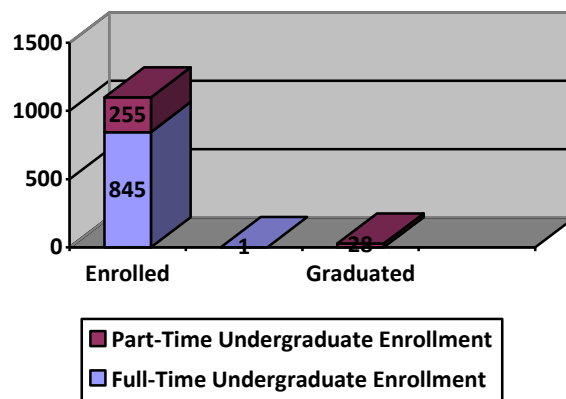

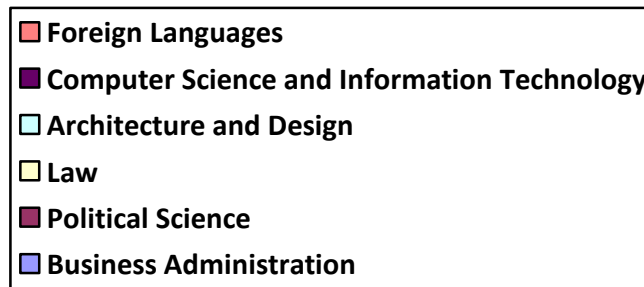
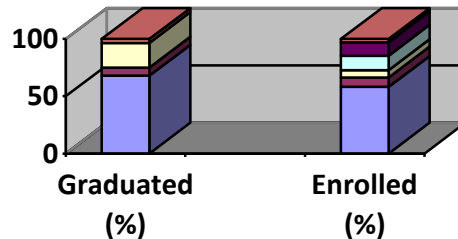

11. Conferences

All across history knowledge has undoubtedly been the building block of human civilizations. The era we currently live in shows special, unprecedented importance that gives due value to knowledge in human life. UACS has been devoted to promoting excellence in higher education and lifelong learning. One objective has been the international conference, which was held for the 4th time this year.

4th Annual International Conference on European Integration

More than 100 attendees and 25 presenters gathered at University American College Skopje on May the 29th for this conference to hear about the threats and opportunities the current economic crisis presents to Europe. Opening remarks by the deputy prime minister, the French ambassador and the regional representative to IFC World Bank set the tone for a day that was full of excellent academic paper



presentations and discussions among the presenting scholars and the audience; the summary of which follows.

This inter- and multi-disciplinary one-day conference explored the current global crisis and its consequences for the future of European integration.

The underlying assumption was that a crisis poses threats to existing structures, values and achievements, but also opens opportunities for critical reassessment and improved solutions to exigent problems. As a hosting academic institution of this conference, we aimed to emphasize and explore the contribution that academia can make to catalyze an adequate response to the crisis. This conference focused on the current global crisis and its consequences for the future of European integration.

Approximately 30 papers were presented at this conference by participants from more than 11 countries. They addressed such questions as:

What impact does the economic downturn have on international relations and the process of EU integration in particular?

What kinds of business strategies should be adopted for economies in the downturn?

Are interventions in the financial sector sufficient to prevent further instability?

Does a crisis of this magnitude trigger critical reconsideration of the idea of a European Union?

How can political, social and cultural considerations contribute to comprehensive solutions towards a new European reality?
